AN ACT to provide for a special Election in the Town of Burlington, in the County of Racine.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That an election shall take place at the Burlington Election, when Exchange, in the town of Burlington, in the county of Racine, on Wednesday, the twenty-fourth day of February, A.D. 1841, for the election of town officers in said town of Burlington.

SEC. 2. Lorenzo D. Eastman, Peter Van Alstine, and Ed. Who are judgward G. Dyer, are hereby appointed judges of the election aforesaid; who shall conduct the same according to the laws now in force in this territory regulating general elections; and shall receive the same remuneration for their services, from the county treasurer.

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the said judges to Notice of elecgive notice that an election will take place at the time and place above named, by posting up notices at three of the most public places in the town of Burlington, at least ten days prior to the day of election.
