An act to appropriate to the several persons the several sums therein named. Chap 174.

*THE people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That there shall be appropriated to be paid out of the state treasury to the following persons the following sums of money, for the purposes therein named, to wit:

SEC. 2. To Bunner and Stafford, five dollars for publishing the official canvass of the general election, 1848. Bunner and Stafford.

SEC. 3. To Beriah Brown, twenty-one dollars and seventy-five cents for publishing by order of the secretary of state. B Brown.

SEC. 4. To Beriah Brown, four hundred and fifty-six dollars and ninety cents for papers furnished the legislature at the present session.

SEC. 5. To Bunner and Stafford forty-six dollars and seventy-five cents for papers furnished the legislature at the present session. Bunner and Stafford.

SEC. 6. To J. F. Jones, forty-six dollars and seventy-five cents for papers furnished at the present session of the legislature. J F Jones.

SEC. 7. To George Hyer twenty-nine dollars and seventy cents, for papers furnished at the present session of the legislature. G Hyer.

SEC. 8. To C. Latham Sholes, sixteen dollars and fifty cents for papers furnished at the present session of the legislature. C L Sholes.

## Chap 175

An act to appropriate to H. A. Tenney the sum therein named.

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

## Chap 176

An act for laying out certain roads therein described.

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Road from Ft Atkinson to M. Point. SECTION 1. Milo Jones, Caleb K. Roby and Chancy Isham are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a certain state road, commencing at the village of Fort Atkinson in Jefferson county, and running westerly on the most practicable route by way
