An Act to amend Chapter 127 of the Revised Statutes.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate

and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: Section 42. The provisions of this chapter shall not be deemed as covering any action cited in section fourteen, wherein it may be shown by the plaintiff, that the person pleading limitation has within the six years been known by another name, or when the fact is established that he has changed his name, or answered habitually to a different name from that by which he was known when the debt or liability was incurred.

An Act to change the course and width of Second street in the village of Whitewater. Chap. 62.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Second street in the village of Whitewater is hereby changed in width and direction as laid down in the recorded plat of said village, as follows: The westerly line of said street to commence ten feet east of the point on Main street where it now commences, and thence to run at right angles to said Main street as far as the northerly side of Centre street,
