The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows: Chap 206

SECTION 1. There is here appropriated to Messrs. Fratney & Hertzberg out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ninety-six dollars, in full of account against the state for publishing general order number four, two months, and for fifty-one copies of the Volksfreund furnished the senate and assembly, and five hundred copies of the governor's message in German, (and translating the same) during the session of 1852.
