Chap 227

An Act to amend an act entitled, "An Act granting to Henry W. King-bury the right to keep and maintain a Ferry across the Wisconsin river."

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Act amended.

SECTION 1. That section three of chapter three hundred and seventy-nine of the session laws of 1851, entitled "An act granting to Henry W. Kingsbury the right to keep and maintain a ferry across the Wisconsin river," and approved March 15th, 1851, is hereby so amended as to prevent the licensing of any ferry within two miles below the point where said ferry is established.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

Chap 228

An Act to appropriate to Lyman Chapin the sum therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Lyman Chapin out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of forty-six dollars and sixty-six cents in full for interest on canal bond number fifty-four from the 20th June, 1851, to the 20th January, 1852.
