

of land out of the corporate limits of said village, for a burial ground or cemetery for said village, on such terms and on such conditions as they may deem necessary for the purpose, the cost of which shall be defrayed by said village.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

An Act to appropriate to Chauncey Abbott the sum therein named.

Chap. 25.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Chauncey Abbott, post master at Madison, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifty-one dollars and ten cents, being for postage of the adjutant general from the 2d to the 16th of June, 1851, and from the 1st of October to the 31st December, 1851.

An Act to appropriate to Duncan C. Reed a certain sum of money.

Chap. 26.
