SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to H. Friend & Brothers the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cents, in full for five gold pens, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An act in relation to Common Schools in the city of Milwaukee," approved February 3, 1846, and to authorize the board of School Commissioners of said city to appoint a superintendent of schools and to settle with the board of a certain school district in the town of Milwaukee

Chap 337

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. An act in relation to common schools in the city of Milwaukee, approved February 3, 1846, is hereby so amended as to authorize the board of school commissioners of the city of Milwaukee to appoint a superintendent of schools for said city, and to fix the amount of his compensation, and to defray all necessary contingent expenses of the board, including the salary of the clerk and of said superintendent.

Act amended.

SEC. 2. The said board of school commissioners shall have authority to settle with the board of a certain school district in the town of Milwaukee, over a part of which district the limits of said city have been extended by "An act to consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Milwaukee and the several acts amendatory thereto," approved February 20th, 1852.

Commissioners may settle with certain district.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage, and all acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.
