Chap 356

An Act to appropriate to H. B. Toussie, the Assignee of Erastus Corning, the sums there in named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to H. B. Toussie, assignee of Erastus Corning, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, payable on the twentieth day of June next, the following sums, to wit: for one bond, number fifty-three, of one thousand dollars, due on the twentieth day of June, A. D. 1851, the sum of one thousand dollars; also, the sum of two hundred and forty-five dollars, being the amount of interest due on said bond; also, the sum of forty dollars and ninety-two cents, for interest due on coupons, attached to said bond.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the treasurer, on the payment of this appropriation, to take up and cancel said bond and coupons.

An Act for the relief of Mathew Short and S. Hart.

Chap 358

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That the price of lot number twenty-eight, in township number fifteen north, of range number seven-teen east, in the south-west quarter of section number sixteen, and containing ten acres of school and university lands, in Fond du Lac county, and sold to Mathew Short and S. Hart, be, and is hereby reduced to twelve dollars per acre.

Price of land reduced.

SEC. 2: That the commissioners for the sale of school and university lands, are hereby authorized and empowered to execute to said Mathew Short and S. Hart a new certificate of purchase for said tract of land, at the reduced price mentioned in section one, and the state treasurer is hereby required to refund to said Short and Hart the amount of percentage and interest paid by them over twelve dollars per acre, out of the income of the school fund.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That the price of lot number twenty-seven, in township number fifteen north, of range number seven-teen east, in the south-west quarter of section number sixteen, and containing ten acres of school and university lands, in Fond du Lac county, and sold to Isaac Tompkins, be and is hereby reduced to twelve dollars per acre.
