Chap 426 An Act granting to Peter Myers the right to keep up and maintain a building in Rock River, at Jan-sville.

> The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Peter Myers is hereby authorized and em-Authorised to Section 1. Feter siyers is need, here building known as a powered to keep up and maintain the building known as a minimum the said Peter Myers, meat market, now occupied by the said Peter Myers, which said building stands in the Rock river, abutting on to the bridge across the said river between the termini upon the same of Milwaukee street, in the village of Janesville, and Milwaukee street in Smith, Bailey, and Stone's Addition to the village of Janesville in Rock county: Provided, That the said building shall not materially obstruct the floatage upon the said river: Provided also, That the said building may be kept and maintained where it now stands so long as the same shall be used as a meat market.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
