Chap 442

*The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to E. B. Kelsey, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents, in full for writing done during the months of January and February for commissioners of school and university lands.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to E. D. Hsley & Co., out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two dollars and sixty-seven cents, (\$2 67) in full for two hundred and forty-three feet of oak boards furnished the state in the month of March, A. D. 1852.
