An Act to authorize the levying and collection of certain special taxes in the Second and Fifth Wards of the City of Milwaukee.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Chap. 78. Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The common council of the city of Milwankee shall have power and it shall be their duty to levy such special taxes in the second and fifth wards of said city, as tax, may be necessary to pay all sums due or to become due, upon contracts for grading side walks in the second ward, and for grading streets or side walks in the fifth ward of said city, entered into previous to the third Tuesday of May, 1851.

SEC. 2. Such taxes shall be levied upon the lots in front of which streets or side walks were made, upon the contracts referred to in the first section of this act, and shall be on what taxes collected in the same manner as other taxes are authorized to be collected in said city.
