

SEC. 15. The directors, before they execute any of the duties of their office except choosing president, shall severally take an oath or affirmation that they will faithfully, diligently, honestly, and impartially perform the duties of their respective offices, according to the best of their ability. Directors to take oath.

SEC. 16. The operations and business of the Beloit Mutual Insurance Company, shall be carried on in the village of Beloit, state of Wisconsin, and this act shall take effect from and after its passage. The legislature of this state may at any time alter, modify, or repeal this act. Business to be carried on at Beloit.

An Act relating to the First Presbyterian Society of Racine.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:* Chap. 82.

SECTION 1. The trustees of the First Presbyterian Society of Racine are hereby authorized to issue the bond of the said Society for the sum of two thousand and five hundred dollars, payable at such time and with such interest, not exceeding the rate of ten per cent. per annum, as they deem proper, and to secure the same by the mortgage of said society upon the lot owned by them, and the brick church erected thereon. Authorized to borrow money.

SEC. 2. Said trustees are also authorized to convey the title or fee simple of the lot owned by them, upon which their wooden church now stands, to such persons or to such religious society, and upon such terms as they shall see fit. May sell lot.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
