

SEC. 9. This act shall take effect, and be in force from and after its passage.

Chap. 50.

An Act to amend Chapter 19, of the Revised Statutes of this State.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Districts to levy tax.

Proviso.

SECTION 1. Chapter 19, of the revised statutes of this state, is hereby amended, so as to provide that no school district in this state, shall levy a tax, except at its first, and each annual meeting: *Provided*, That no person shall be entitled to vote in any school district of this state, who is not qualified to vote at a general election for state and county officers, and who shall not have resided at least ten days in the district where he or they may offer to vote.

Clerk to make out tax list.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the clerk of each district, on or before the second Monday in October, in each year, to make out a tax list of the taxes legally voted by his district, and deliver such list, with his affidavit attached thereto, setting forth that the whole of the taxes contained in such list, were lawfully levied or assessed, according to the provisions of this act, to the town clerk of the town in which the lands taxed are situate, and he shall also notify the district treasurer of the amount of such tax.

Certificate to be filed.

SEC. 3. The town clerk, upon delivery to him of such list, shall give a certificate to the district clerk, of the amount of said list, which certificate shall be filed in the office of the said district clerk.

How tax collected.

SEC. 4. Such town clerk shall, in making out the duplicate assessment roll of the town, next thereafter enter such tax in a separate column therein, opposite the description of the lands upon which the taxes are so levied respectively, and such taxes shall be collected in the same manner as the town and county taxes are collected, and when collected, shall be paid over to the town superintendent of such town, who shall pay the same to the treasurer of the district in which such taxes were originally levied.

SEC. 5. All provisions of chapter 19, of the revised statutes of this state, which conflict with, or contravene the provisions or any provision of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of September next.
