Account of expenditure—how kept.

§ 2. It shall be the duty of the executive committee of the said State Historical Society of Wisconsin, to keep an accurate account of the manner of expenditure of the said sum of money hereby appropriated, and transmit the same, together with the vouchers therefor, to the Governor of this State, in the month of January in each year, to be by him laid before the legislature.

§ 3. This act shall take effect, and be in force from and

after its passage.

Chap. 17.

AN ACT to repeal chapter seventy-nine of session laws of 1853, entitled an act concerning bills of exchange and promissory notes.

Published April 23, 1854.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Act repealed,

- § 1. Chapter seventy-nine of the session laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-three, entitled "an act concerning bills of exchange and promissory notes," is hereby repealed; *Provided*, That this act shall in no wise effect any promissory note or bill of exchange due before this act shall take effect.
- § 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after it passage.
