## Chap. 30.

AN ACT concerning elections.

Published, March 30, 1854.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. At any election for county judge, judge of the circuit court, or justice of the supreme court, a poll may be opened at any place duly designated therefor, according to the statutes of this state regulating general elections, and the votes given at such poll shall be canvassed and return thereof made in like manner as at the general election for county and state officers; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

§ 2. This act shall take effect from its passage and pub-

lication.

## Chap. 31.

AN ACT concerning judgments and executions issued thereon in the County Courts.

Published, March 30, 1854.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senats and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The provisions of sections one hundred and eighteen, one hundred and nineteen, one hundred and twenty and one hundred and twenty-one, of chapter one hundred and two of the revised statutes, (sections 118, 119, 126 and 121, of chapter 102,) shall apply in all cases to judgments and writs of executions and all other proceedings
