AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to amend chapter forty-one of the Revised Statutes, approved April 2, 1853."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Act amended.

§ 1. The act to which this is amendatory is hereby amended by striking out the words, "not within the municipal jurisdiction of and such city or town."

§ 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage

and publication.

Chap. 10.

AN ACT to divide LaPointe county and create the county of Douglass.

Published, February 11, 1854.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Boundary of county.

§ 1. All that portion of country now embraced in La-Pointe county, lying and being west of range nine (9) west, shall be and is hereby set off into a separate county to be called and known as the county of Douglass.

Election when held. § 2. There shall be an election held in the several towns and precincts such as now are or may be hereafter established by law, on the first Tuesday in April, A. D. 1854, for the election of all such town officers as the said county by virtue of its organization and privileges of this act
