An Act for attaching Columbia County to the Ninth Judicial Circuit.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The county of Columbia is hereby attached to, and shall constitute a part of, the ninth judicial circuit of this state.

SEC. 2. The time for holding the regular terms of the Time of hold-circuit courts, in said county of Columbia, shall be on the ing court in second Monday of February and on the second Monday Columbia co. of September in each year.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after the second Monday of April next.

An Act for the protection of Laborers on Railroads.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SEC. 1. All railroad corporations within this state shall Railroad cerbe responsible and obligated in law to the laborers on the porations reline or lines of railroads being constructed by said corpolaborers.
