

courts of this state," approved October 10th, 1856, shall take effect and be in force on the first day of March next, and not before, and all acts and parts of acts repealed by the act of which this is amendatory, shall remain in full force and effect until the first day of March next, and no longer.

SEC. 2. So much of the act of which this is amendatory, as conflicts with the provisions of this act, is hereby repealed.

All parts of code inconsistent herewith repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication, and this act shall be published in connection with the act of which it is amendatory.

When this act takes effect.

## CHAPTER 128.

*Published November 18.*

An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to authorize the Secretary of State to employ and pay clerks for actual and necessary discharge of the duties of his office," approved March 29th, 1856.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The secretary of state shall audit, and the state treasurer shall pay such sum or sums as shall be actually and necessarily expended for clerk hire in the bank comptroller's office, in the same manner as is provided in the act of which this is amendatory for clerks employed in the said secretary of states office; *Provided*, That before the secretary of state shall audit any account for clerk hire in the bank comptroller's office, the bank comptroller shall file with him a certificate, setting forth the particular service rendered by such clerk or clerks, and that the same was necessary to enable him to keep up the business of his office.

Secretary to audit account for clerk hire.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
