CHAPTER 19.

Published March 17.

An Act to appropriate to the Wiscousin Institute for the education of the Blind, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

Appropriation for institution for blind.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsin Institute for the education of the blind, the sum of five thousand dollars for the support of said institute, from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, to the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, to be levied and collected in the tax of eighteen hundred and fifty six, and paid to said institution in the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven.

To complete building. SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to said institution the further sum of ten thousand dollars for the completion of the main building of said institution according to the plan of the same.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 20.

Published March 17.

An Act to authorize the Secretary of State to audit the account of the Post Meater at Madison.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Secretary of state to audit account of pestmaster.

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the secretary of state to audit the account of the post master at Madison, for postage of members of the senate and assembly from March 7, 1856, to the close of the present session of the
