legislature, and when so audited and allowed, the same shall be paid by the state treasurer on the order of the secretary of state out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated.

CHAPTER 21.

Published March 22.

An Act to remit certain forfeitures, and extend time for payment of School or University Land interest.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All forfeitures that have accrued to this Forfeitures restate, in consequence of the non payment of any interest mitted. due the state on any loan from the school or university funds, or on account of any interest due on account of school and university lands, in any manner, on the fifth day of March, A. D. 1856, are hereby remitted to the persons respectively from whom interest was due, and if any such person shall have paid any such forfeiture between the fifth of March aforesaid, and the passage of this act, the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to place the amount thus paid as forfeiture, to the credit of the person who may have so paid the same, and apply the same to the payment of the interest which shall be due from said persons next year, and the time for payment of interest due the state as aforesaid, for the present year, is hereby extended to the first day of May, A. D. 1856.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force and go into effect from and after its passage.
