An Act to change the name of Adolphina Frantz to Adolphina Frantz Downs

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed

SECTION 1. The name of Adolphina Frantz, now living in the town of Grafton, Ozaukee county, is hereby changed to Adolphina Frantz Downs, by which name she shall hereafter be known in law, for all purposes whatever.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its pas-

sage.

CHAPTER 39.

Published April 23.

An Act to fix the time of holding the terms of the Circuit Court in the Third
Judicial Circuit.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Time of holding court in certain counties,

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court for the third judicial circuit, shall be held as follows: In the county of Marquette, on the first Monday in March, and on the second Monday of September, in each year. In the county of Dodge, on the third Monday in March, and the fourth Monday in September, in each year. In the county of Washington, on the first Monday in April, and the second Monday in October, in each year. In the county of Ozaukee, on the third Monday of April and the fourth Monday in October, in each year.

Writs, &c. returnable. SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after the first day of June next, and all writs, processes, recognizances or other proceedings made returnable by any laws of this
