An Act to change the name of Henriette Selsemeier to Henriette Kirchheck.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in , Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of Henriette Selsemeier, daughter Namechanged of Charles Selsemeier and Fredericka Kirchheck, formerly Selsemeier, of the town of Herman, in the county of Sheboygan, is hereby changed to that of Henriette Kirchheck, and by the last mentioned name she shall be hereafter known and recognized.

SEC. 2. The said Henriette Kirchheck shall be the adopted Made heir-atdaughter and heir at-law of Willhelm Kirchheck and Fred-law, a ericka Kirchheck, of said town of Herman, and be entitled to all the rights and privileges of inheritance, support and maintenance, as fully and in the same manner, as if she were the legitimate child of the said Willhelm and Fredericka Kirchheck.

SNO. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
