

CHAPTER 68.

Published May 13.

An Act to change the name of certain persons therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed SECTION 1. The names of Frederick Joseph Hoffman, Matthew John Hoffman and Christine Leonore Hoffman, of the city of Milwaukee, in the county of Milwaukee, are hereby changed respectively to Frederick Joseph Becker, Matthew John Becker and Christine Leonore Becker, and by the last mentioned names they shall respectively hereafter be known and recognized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 69.

Published May 13.

An Act to authorize the Secretary of State to audit certain accounts for Newspapers.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Secretary of state to audit accounts for newspapers furnished. SECTION 1. The secretary of state or assistant secretary of state is hereby authorized and required to audit the accounts of the several newspaper publishers of this state, for newspapers furnished the assembly during the present session, and to settle such accounts, allowing said publishers at the advertised rates of such papers per year for the time such papers were furnished.

Legislature. SEC. 2. Such accounts shall be verified by oath of such publishers, that the papers were ordered, either by the clerk of the senate, [assembly] or the persons to whom they were

sent, and furnished, accompanied by a statement of the yearly terms of such papers.

SEC. 3. The secretary of state or assistant secretary of Warrants. state, is authorized to draw warrants on the state treasury in favor of the respective publishers, for the amounts found due them, and there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, a sum sufficient to meet said drafts.

CHAPTER 70.

Published May 13.

An Act to authorize the Secretary of State to audit a certain account.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to audit and allow the account of George F. O. Steche for his services as mail porter of the several state departments during the present session of the legislature, and to draw orders on the state treasurer for the amount found due to him; and there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to meet said drafts.

Secretary of state to audit a certain account.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
