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second Monday of May and the third Monday of October of each year; in the county of Crawford on the fourth Monday of May and the second Monday of November of each year; in the county of Bad Axe on the second Monday of June and on the second Monday of December of each year.

Relative to prosess and proceedings heretofore lesued.

§2. All process, proceedings and recognizances, heretofore commenced or issued, or which may be commenced or issued, in or from said Courts, or either of them, and all proceedings pending therein or returnable thereto, whether by recognizance or otherwise, shall be held and taken as returnable at the times named in this act as the times for holding the said Courts respectively.

§ 3. All acts contravening the provisions of this act

are hereby repealed.

§ 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 143 of the Session Laws of 1856, entitled, "An Act to amend Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Chap. 148, Laws of 1856 repealed.

- § 1. That Chapter one hundred and forty-three (143) of the general laws of 1856, entitled "An Act to amend Chapter twenty-four of the Revised Statutes," be and the same is hereby repealed; and all acts and parts of acts repealed by the enactment of the said Chapter one hundred and forty-three are hereby revived.
- § 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
