AN ACT to appropriate three thousand dollars for the purchase of Stationary for the use of the State Officers and the next Legislature.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Stationary for State Officers.

§ 1. The sum of three thousand dollars, (\$3,000) out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the purchase of Stationary for the use of the State Officers and Legislature for the ensuing year. The money to be drawn from the Treasury by the person whom the Governor may appoint to purchase said Stationary, after such person has given the bonds required by law.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

AN ACT to provide for levying a State tax for the year 1857.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

State tax for

§ 1. There shall be levied and collected for the year 1857, a State tax of three hundred thousand dollars, to be apportioned among, and assessed upon the several counties of this State, as provided in chapter seventy-three of the session laws of 1854, entitled "an act to establish a board of equalization of State tax for the year 1854," approved April 1st, 1854; and shall be levied upon the property real and personal in this State, according to the equalization to be made the present year, by the State board of equalization, which tax
