AN ACT to amend Chapter 119 of the General Laws of 1856, entitled "An Act to authorize County Boards of Supervisors to order the publication of public notices relating to foreign affairs and foreign languages."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. Section one of Chapter one hundred and nine-ch. 119 have teen of the General Laws of Wisconsin for the year 1856, is hereby so amended as to read, in all cases, when the Board of Superviso's of any county in this State shall deem it necessary for the better information of the inhabitants thereof, they may order public notices relating to tax sales or other affairs of said county to be published in one newspaper, published in any other than the English language; *Provided*, That all such notices shall be published in a newspaper published in the English language as heretofore required by law.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT in relation to the duties and compensation of the Clerks of the Supreme Court.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

§ 1. If at any term of the Supreme Court of this Duty of Clerk of State, a quorum of the justices of said Court shall not attend on the first day of the term, the clerk shall enter such fact on the record and the court shall stand ad-
