AN ACT to provide for auditing the accounts of the Revisers.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The Secretary of State is hereby directed and see, of State to authorized to audit the accounts of the persons appoint. Revisers ed under the provisions of an act entitled "An Act to provide for a revision of the General Laws of the State of Wisconsin," approved October 13, 1856, for services performed under the provisions of said act from time to time, when presented by said Revisers upon the certificate of said Revisers, stating the number of days actual service rendered by each, and to draw warrants upon the State Treasurer for the amounts audited, and a sufficient sum of money is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated to pay such warrants.

AN ACT to change the fiscal year of the State of Wisconsin, and to amend an act relating to printing, approved April 19, 1852.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. Section thirty one of Chapter nine of the Revised Floral year of Statutes is hereby amended so that the fiscal year of this State shall hereafter commence on the first day of October in each year, and close on the thirtieth day of September next succeeding.
