## Chapter 1.

Published January 20th, 1858.

An Aor for the auditing and payment of the Postage of the Members and Officers of the Senate and Assembly and State Officers.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby author-Secretary of ized and required to audit the accounts for postage of state authorized to audit the Members of the Legislature and Officers thereof, Expostage acceutive Office, Office of Secretary of State, Attorney counts. General, State Superintendent, State Treasurer, Clerk of the Supreme Court and Superintendent of Public Property; said accounts to be certified by the Postmaster at Madison, by affidavit.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Post-Money appromaster at Madison, out of any money in the State priated. Treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient for the payment of the above accounts, to be drawn from the treasury upon the presentation of said accounts properly certified.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
