

Chapter 23.

Published March 19th, 1858.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to extend the time for the payment of the interest due the Swamp Land and School Fund of this State.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The provisions of the act entitled "an act To extend to University fund. to extend the time for the payment of the interest due the swamp land and school fund of this State," approved March 6th, 1858, shall extend equally to the University fund.

SEC. 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized to remit all penalties for the non-payment of interest or any indebtedness to the State which may have accrued between the fifth day of March, 1858, and the publication of this act, and the act to which this is amendatory. Authorized to remit penalties.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Chapter 24.

AN ACT to authorize the State Superintendent to apportion to the Counties of Columbia, Dane and Jackson, the sums of money therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The State Superintendent of Public In- Required to apportion in addition to regular apportionment certain sums.struction is hereby authorized and required to apportion, in addition to the regular apportionment for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, to the county of Columbia, forty-eight dollars and thirty cents; to the county of Dane, three hundred and twenty-one dollars and forty-two cents; and to the county of Jackson, three hundred and thirty dollars; being the amount

due and not apportioned to said counties for the year 1856.

To apportion

SEC. 2. The Treasurer of the county of Columbia is hereby authorized and required to apportion to the town of West Point, the sum of forty-eight dollars and thirty cents in addition to the regular apportionment of said town for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.

To town of
Pleasant
Spring.

SEC. 3. The Treasurer of the county of Dane is hereby authorized and required to apportion to the town of Pleasant Spring, the sum of three hundred and twenty-one dollars and forty-two cents, in addition to the regular apportionment to said town for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

To towns of
Albion, Alma,

SEC. 4. The Treasurer of the county of Jackson is hereby authorized and required to apportion to the town of Albion, the sum of one hundred and fifty-two dollars and forty-six cents; to the town of Alma, the sum of sixty-two dollars and seventy cents; to the town of Bristol, the sum of forty-two dollars and twenty-four cents; to the town of Irving, the sum of fifty-two dollars and fourteen cents; and to the town of Manchester the sum of seventy dollars and forty-six cents, in addition to the regular apportionment to said towns for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the Clerk of the Revisors.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
