AN Act to fix the Compensation of the Revisors of the General Laws of the State.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to F. S. Appropriated Lovell, S. J. Todd and David Taylor, the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty dollars each out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full for services as Revisors of the general laws of this State.

SEC. 2. The several sums of money audited by the To be consid-Secretary of State, and paid out of the State treasury to ered part of said Revisors under the provisions of chapter 98 of the ation. general laws of 1857, shall be considered a part of the appropriation made by this act, and shall be deducted therefrom, and the balance, after making such deduc-tion, shall be paid by the State Treasurer under the provisions of this act.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
