

**Chapter 9.***Published February 13th, 1858.*

AN ACT concerning Contempts.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*Contempt—  
punishment.

SECTION 1. Whenever either house of the legislature shall order or direct the imprisonment of any person for a contempt or breach of its privileges, such person shall be committed to the common jail of the county of Dane, and the jailor of such jail is hereby directed to receive such person, and detain him in close confinement for the term specified in the order of imprisonment, unless he shall be sooner discharged by the order of such house of the legislature, or by due course of law.

SEC. 2. This act shall be immediately published by the State printer, and shall then take effect.

**Chapter 10.***Published February 18th, 1858.*

AN ACT to amend an act for fixing the time for holding the Terms of the Circuit Court of Oconto County.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*Change of  
term time.

SECTION 1. The next term of the circuit court of Oconto county, shall be held on the second Monday of June next, and thereafter the terms of the circuit court for said county of Oconto, shall be held on the second Mondays of June and February in each year.

Process, pro-  
ceedings, &c.

SEC. 2. All process, proceedings and recognizances taken, and theretofore commenced, or issued, or which may be taken, commenced, or issued, in or from said court, and all proceedings pending therein, or returnable thereto, whether by recognizance, continuance or otherwise, shall be held and taken to be continued and returnable at the first term of said court, to be held as provided in this act.
