deliver such securities in amount and kind, as may be deemed expedient by said corporation for all purposes, in carrying out the objects of this company; and the official acts of said company are hereby declared binding in law and equity upon said corporation, and upon all other parties to such contract.

How construed, &c. SEC. 10. This act shall be favorably construed to effect the purpose thereby intended, and the same is hereby declared to be a public act, and copies thereof, printed by authority of the State, shall be received as evidence thereof, and the works of said company shall be completed within two years from the date of the organization of said company.

SEC. 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

An Aor to appropriate to the Wisconsin Institute for the Education of the Blind certain sums of money therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

\$7,530 79 appropriated. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsign Institute for the Education of the Blind, the sum of seven thousand five hundred and thirty dollars and seventy-nine cents, for the purpose of paying the debts of the institution now due and payable.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated the further sum of five thousand dollars for the support of the said institute until the 1st day of February, A. D. 1859.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.
