CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT to enlarge the civil jurisdiction of the county court of La Crosse county.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county court of the county of La Crosse shall hereafter have concurrent and co-extensive jurisdiction with the circuit court of said county in all civil actions, matters and proceedings in said county, and may exercise the same power and authority in all cases as the circuit court in said county, and the rules of practice for the circuit court now in force, and that may hereafter be made and provided for said courts, shall be applicable to, and govern the practice in said county court of La Crosse county.

SEC. 2. So much of the provisions of section 46, of chapter 117, of the revised statutes, entitled "of county courts having civil jurisdiction," and such parts of any other act or acts as conflict with the provisions of this act are, for the purposes of this act only, hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT supplemental to chapter 78 of the revised statutes, relating to corporations.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. All the provisions of law relating to the sale of the property, rights and franchises of any railroad company, by any trustee or mortgagee, and to the redemption thereof by the stockholders or creditors, are hereby extended to, and shall embrace all other companies organized under the laws of this state, except as otherwise provided by special act.
