CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT to amend chapter 27 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and dis-tribution of stationery for the use of the state."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section 9, of chapter 27, of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to the same the following words: "Provided, that the amount of stationery furnished in any one year to each and every member of the legislature, the lieutenant governor, and the sergeant-at-arms of each house, shall not exceed in value fifteen dollars."
