CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT to amend section 59, of chapter 28, of the revised statutes, entitled "Of school and university lands."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifty-nine, of chapter twenty-eight **Amendment.** of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to said section the following words: "and if, on a resale of such land, the same shall produce more than sufficient to pay the sum owing therefor, with interest and costs, and five per cent. damages on the amount of purchase money unpaid, the residue, when collected, shall be paid over to the former purchaser, or his legal representative.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from **Take effect.** and after its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, entitled "Of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine, of chapter twenty-seven, of **Amendment.** the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to the same the following words: "*Provided*, that the amount of stationery furnished in any one year to each and every member of the legislature, the lieutenant governor, and the sergeant-at-arms of each house, shall not exceed in value fifteen dollars."
