CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to amend section four, of chapter eighteen, of the general laws of 1858, entitled "An act to provide for the publication and distribution of the laws of Wisconsin concerning the organization and government of towns."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

Section 1. So much of section four of chapter eighteen of the general laws of 1858, as requires the superintendent of public property to send "at the special request of some member of the legislature," by express, for distribution, the laws concerning the organization and government of towns, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Laws—to whom delivered.

SEC. 2. The laws referred to in the act to which this is amendatory, shall be delivered to the members of the present legislature by the superintendent of public property in the proportion designated in said act, to be distributed by them in the several towns of this state, at their discretion.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend subdivision 2, of section 25, of chapter 19, of the z[revised statutes, relating to the assessment of highway taxes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact a follows:

Amendments.

SECTION 1. Subdivision two, of section twenty-five, of chapter nineteen, is hereby amended so that wherever the word "three" occurs in said subdivision, it shall in lieu thereof be read "one."

SEO. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
