CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT in relation to the payment of state tax in the counties of Douglass and La Pointe.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Relating to the state tax. SECTION 1. The counties of Douglass and La Pointe shall not incur the penalty provided by law, for non-payment of state taxes, at the time required by law, provided the said counties shall pay to the state treasury the amount due from them respectively, on or before the second Monday of July, in each and every year.

Penalty remitted. SEC. 2. The penalty of twenty-five per cent. imposed upon said counties for delinquency in the payment of the state tax for the year 1858, is hereby remitted.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to fix the time for holding courts in the Tenth Judicial Circuit, and summoning jury therein.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The circuit courts in the tenth judicial Time of hold-circuit shall be holden as follows: In the county of Brown, on the fourth Mondays of January and May, and the first Monday of October, of each year. In the county of Winnebago, on the second Monday of April, the second Monday of September, and the second Monday in
