AN ACT to repeal chapter 11. of the General Laws of 1858. entitled "An act to authorize the judge of the sixth [judicial] circuit to appoint a place for holding the circuit court in the county of Buffalo."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Act repealed.

SECTION 1. Chapter eleven, of the General Laws of 1858, entitled "An act to authorize the judge of the sixth judicial circuit to appoint a place for holding the circuit court in the county of Buffalo," approved February 20th, 1858, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to legalize the organization of joint school district No. 2, in the towns of Adrian and Tomah, in the county of Monroe.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Organization legalized.

SECTION 1. The acts and proceedings of joint school district No. 2, in the towns of Adrian and Tomah, in the county of Monroe, in perfecting the organization of said district, are hereby declared legal and valid, to all intents and purposes.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.
