CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to provide for laying out a state road from Shawano to the State line.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Hiram Wescott, Talbot Pricket, and William Grimmer, are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and locate a state road from Shawano, in township twenty-seven, range fifteen, in Shawano [Shawanaw] county, by the most practicable route, to connect at the State line with the state road now in process of construction in the State of Michigan, from L'Anse southward to the State line.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners shall receive for their services such compensation as the county board of supervisors, of the counties through which the road may pass, shall allow.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
