AN ACT to amend section two (2), of chapter one hundred and forty, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of miscellaneous proceedings in civil actions, and general provisions."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment,

SECTION 1. The second section, of chapter one hundred and forty, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended, by adding a provision, as follows: "Provided, that if such judgment be against such deceased debtor, and others jointly, execution may be issued in the usual manner, against such of the judgment debtors as survive."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.
