CHAPTER 185.

AN ACT to amend chapter 40 of the Local Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to authorize the city of Milwaukee to assess water rents."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows.

SECTION 1. Section one (1), of chapter 40, of the Private and Local Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to authorize the city of Milwaukee to assess water rents," is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section a proviso in the following words, viz: "And *Provided, further,* That no such water rates [rents] shall be assessed upon any property, the owner or occupant of which shall not receive or use water from such pipes thereon." Water rents not to be assessed on certain property.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT to change the boundaries of the town of Watertown, in the county of Jefferson.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections one, two, three, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen and fifteen, of township number eight north, of range fourteen east, are hereby detached from the town of Watertown, in Jefferson county, and attached to the town of Milford in said county of Jefferson, and shall hereafter form a part of Milford, for all purposes whatsoever. Territory attached to town of Milford.

§ 2. It is hereby declared to be the judgment of this Legislature that the objects sought to be reached by this act, cannot be obtained under or by any general law of this State.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
