

CHAPTER 2.

[Published January 20, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 185, of the General Laws of 1859, being an act entitled "An act to construe chapter 20, of the Revised Statutes, entitled 'Of regulating fences.'" .

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The said act is hereby amended by striking out the word "fences," where it occurs in the title and body of the same, and inserting the word "ferries," in lieu thereof.

CHAPTER 3.

[Published January 25, 1860.]

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Peter Haroldson, as Justice of the Peace in the county of Dane.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by Peter Haroldson, as justice of the peace in the town of Vermont, in the county of Dane, in this State, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this State, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said Peter Haroldson had caused his official bond or bonds, and oath or oaths, to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes.

Legalizing the official acts of Peter Haroldson, J. P., Dane county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
