SEC. 7. This act shall, immediately after its passage, be printed by the State Printer, and when so printed, shall take effect and be in full force.

AN AUT to amend chapter one hundred and sixty (160), of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to prescribe and limit the rate of interest."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, of chapter 160, of the Gene-Rate of interral Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to prescribe and limit est limited to the rate of interest," is hereby amended by striking out 10 per ct. the word "twelve," where it occurs in said section, and insert in lieu thereof the word "ten."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 203.

AN ACT to amend chapter 104, of the Private and Local Laws of 1858, relating to a certain state road therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of an act, entitled "An act Amendment. to provide a special tax to improve a road therein named, in the county of Manitowoc," approved March 25th, A. D., 1858, is hereby amended as follows: strike out the name of Lindsey Dunham, in second line of section one, and insert in lieu thereof, the name of James Cahill.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
