AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to appropriate the islands in the Wisconsin river, between a line [running] parallel with the fourth principal meridian, ten miles east thereof, and a line [running] parallel with said meridian, nine miles west thereof, to the Muscoda and Richland Bridge Company.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, of chapter ninety-two, of the Amendment General Laws of 1859, is hereby amended by striking out the name "B. M. Coates," from the sixth line, and inserting in place thereof, the name of J. B. Moore, who is hereby vested with all of the rights, under the same restrictions, with which the said B. M. Coates was vested by said chapter.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT to amend section one, of chapter 113, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "of the liens of mechanics and others."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, of chapter 113, of the Gen-Amendment eral Laws of 1859, entitled an act to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-three, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of the lien of mechanics and others," is hereby amended by striking out the words "ninety days," and inserting the words "six months," in lieu thereof.
