Section fifty-four, of said chapter, is hereby amended, by inserting between the words "township," and "twenty," in the sixth line of said section, the following words: "twenty-four and twenty-five north, thence east on said township line, to the line between ranges fifteen and sixteen east, thence north on said range line to the township line between townships."

## CHAPTER 218.

[Published April 13, 1860.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of a special tax in that part of joint school district No. 9, in the towns of Fox Lake and Courtland, being in the town of Fox Lake.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Time extended.;

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of a special tax in that part of joint school district No. 9, in the towns of Fox Lake and Courtland, being in the town of Fox Lake, is hereby extended to the first day of June, 1860.

Powers of town treasurer. SEC. 2. The town treasurer of the town of Fox Lake, shall possess all the powers in collecting and making return of the said special tax, that are conferred upon him in collecting any general tax.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
