

CHAPTER 273.

[Published April 12, 1860.]

AN ACT to re-annex certain lands to the towns of Milwaukee, Wauwatosa, Greenfield, and Lake, in the county of Milwaukee.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The east halves of sections number thirteen (13), twenty-four (24), twenty-five (25), and thirty-six (36), in township number seven (7), north of range twenty-one (21) east, except so much of section twenty-five (25) as lies within the present limits of the fourth ward of said city of Milwaukee, are hereby, for all purposes, re-annexed to, and made a part of the town of Wauwatosa, in the county of Milwaukee. Parts of 4th ward of Milwaukee annexed to Wauwatosa.

SEC. 2. The east half of section number one (1), in township number six (6), north of range number twenty-one (21) east, except so much thereof as lies within the present limits of the eighth ward of said city, is hereby, for all purposes, re-annexed to and made a part of the town of Greenfield, in the county of Milwaukee. Annexed to town of Greenfield.

SEC. 3. So much of any act or acts, amendatory of an act, entitled "An act to consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Milwaukee, and the several acts amendatory thereof," as conflict with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SEC. 4. This act shall be immediately published, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
