SEC. 2. Section fifteen, of the act of which this act is amendatory, is hereby amended by inserting therein, after the word "larceny," the words "or misdemeanor."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 279.

[Published April 17, 1860.]

AN ACT for the protection of orchards and fruit trees.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amendment to sec. 51, chap. 165, R S SECTION 1. Section fifty-one, of chapter one hundred and sixty-five, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, to wit: "or by imprisonment in the county jail not more than thirty days, nor less than five days."

Amendment to sec. 52. SEC. 2. Section fifty-two, of said chapter, is amended by adding thereto the following: "or by imprisonment in the county jail, not more than three months, nor less than ten days."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 280.

[Published April 20, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of trustees of the village of Viroqua, Bad Ax county, to levy a tax.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Tax for corporation purposes. SECTION 1. The board of trustees, in the village of Viroqua, in the county of Bad Ax, are hereby authorized to levy, for corporation purposes, a tax, not to exceed one per cent. on the taxable real and personal property, situate within the corporate limits of said village, as the same

appears on the assessment roll for the town of Viroqua, in said county, for the year 1859.

SEC. 2. The board of trustees, of said village of Viroqua, are hereby authorized to copy, from the assessment roll for the said town of Viroqua, for the year 1859, a list of all the real and personal property situate within the corporate limits of said village, together with the assessed value of the same, as it shall appear on said roll; and such list, when transcribed by the said board of trustees, shall constitute the assessment roll for said village, for the purpose of raising the tax hereby authorized.

SEC. 3. Said tax shall be collected by the marshal, and by him returned and paid over to the treasurer of the village of Viroqua, within sixty days from and after the passage of this act. It shall not be necessary for the marshal of said village to give any notice of the tax list being in his possession, but he shall proceed to collect said tax, immediately on receiving from the said board of trustees the tax list, with their warrant, for collection.

Marshal to collect and pay over tax. Notice not necessary.

SEC. 4. The marshal of the said village shall have the same right to levy on, and sell, any personal property of any person charged with a tax in such list, as is conferred on village marshals by section forty-eight, of chapter seventy, Revised Statutes of this State.

Marshal may sell personal property.

SEC. 5. The marshal shall be entitled to five per cent. on all taxes so assessed, which shall be added to and carried out as a part of said tax.

Fees.

SEC. 6. The treasurer of the said village of Viroqua shall sell all lots and parcels of land returned, by the said marshal, delinquent, according to the provisions of chapter seventy, of the Revised Statutes.

Treasurer to sell delinquent lands.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
