AN ACT to grant a certain island in the Wisconsin river, in the county of Wood, to Orestes Garrison and H. W. Jackson.

CHAPTER 287.

AN ACT to provide for laying out a State road from Chilton, in Calumet county, to Wrightstown, in Brown county.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Commissioners named—and route of road.

SECTION 1. Hoel S. Wright, Asaph Green, and O. R. Potter are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a State road from the town of Chilton, in Calumet county, to Wrightstown, in Brown county, in the State of Wisconsin.

Report of survey to be made to clerk of county.

SEC. 2. Said commissioners shall, immediately after laying out said road, cause a report of their survey to be made and filed with the clerk of the board of supervisors of each county, through which such road passes, and shall comply, in all respects, with chapter nineteen, of the Statutes, so far as the same are applicable.

Compensation

SEC. 3. Such commissioners shall be entitled to such compensation as the board of supervisors of each county through which said road shall pass, shall deem proper, and the same shall be paid by said counties respectively:

proviso.

Provided, that no compensation shall be allowed for lay-

ing out so much of said road as may lie upon any other road which may have been laid out at the time of laying out said State road.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. H. H. Deyarman, Capt. Andrew Moore, Commission-
and Lucius L. Fisher, are hereby appointed commission-^{ers}.
ers with full power to lay out and establish a state road
from the village of Eau Claire city, in Eau Claire county, ^{Route of road.}
to the mouth of Hay river, in the county of Dunn.
