

## CHAPTER 32.

[Published February 11, 1860.]

AN ACT to prescribe the time for holding the terms of the circuit court in La Fayette county, in the fifth judicial circuit.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That, hereafter, the general terms of the circuit court in and for the county of La Fayette, in the fifth judicial circuit of this State, shall be held as follows : on the third Monday in April, and on the fourth Monday in October, of each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, summons, process, indictments, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to the terms of the circuit court in and for said county, now fixed by law, shall be returnable to the terms herein provided ; and all adjournments, appearances, continuances, motions, and notices of any proceedings in the circuit court of said county, made or taken to any term of a date subsequent to the date when this act shall take effect, shall be held and taken for the time herein provided for holding the terms of said court.

SEC. 3. All acts, and parts of acts, conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

Repeal.

SEC. 4. This act, immediately after its passage, shall be published in a newspaper printed in said county of La Fayette, and it is hereby made the duty of the Secretary of State to immediately furnish a copy of this act to the publisher of a paper in said county, for publication.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
