SEC. 4. The Prison Commissioner shall keep a record Prison com. of such receipts, so given by him, and report the same to keep record with his annual report, and the Secretary of State shall

file in his office the receipt presented to him.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized, Sec'y of state in cases where he is satisfied that the State Prison Com-authorized to missioner has certified the number of miles too large, tanee charged to reduce the same so as to make it comply with the actual distance.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 344.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend section fifteen, of chapter 183, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "An act of offences cognizable before Justices of the Peace."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifteen, of chapter 183, of the Silver Lake, Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding the in Sheboygan words "except Silver Lake, in Sheboygan county," Co. excepted after the word "state," and before the word "for," in the third line of said section fifteen, of chapter 183.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
